Notes:

1. Must not hold any TC pilot license. **Must turn 16 by 1 Sep 2020**, be physically fit, must have a Category 3 Medical issued by a Canadian Civil Aviation Medical Examiner.
2. **Must be 17 by 1 Sep 2020**, be physically fit, must have a Category 3 Medical issued by a Canadian Civil Aviation Medical Examiner.
3. Staff Applications do not require a summer training application; cadets must inform the training staff of their requested position selections. Staff Cadets **must be 16 years of age** by first day of contract to be eligible. Staff Cadet billets will be distributed separately.
 - a. Returning Staff Cadets must apply by **26 Nov 2019**.
 - b. New Staff Cadets must apply by **21 Jan 2020**.
4. Music Course applicants require a recommendation from the Band Officer.
5. National courses are only for cadets in **level 3 or above** and have additional application requirements. By regulations, **779 may only submit one applicant** for AATC-AO, AATC-AM, AASC.
 - a. A cadet may only apply for one course amongst IACE, GPS or PPS.
 - i. For 2020, 779 may submit **4 applicants** for GPS and PPS. Up to 3 cadets may be selected for course.
 - b. A cadet may only apply for one course amongst AATC-AO, AATC-AM, AASC.
6. Must successfully complete required training level and have a minimum of 60% attendance.
7. Any cadet that turns 19 years of age before the end of summer training is NOT ELIGIBLE to submit an application.
8. Yearly Validation must be completed and (if applicable) the DHQ (detailed health questionnaire or DND2570) must be completed and received by RCLMO.
9. A new selection process for National Courses has been implemented for Summer 2020. The full description is available in the following publication: **Natl CJCR Sp Gp 7003-1-13**. An electronic copy will be made available on the Squadron Website for download and review by all National Course Applicants. Important details to know are:
 - a. Only IACE, PPS and GPS will have interviews.
 - b. Applications for AATC-AO, AATC-AM and AASC will be scored based on entries in FORTRESS.
 - c. No Narratives are required to be submitted.
 - d. Natl CJCR Sp Gp 7003-1-13 will be the authoritative source on the National Course Application process. No OPC Manual will be published.
 - e. School Transcripts (all National applications), Height and Weight Forms (PPS & GPS), IACE Destination Form (printed from FORTRESS) and a copy of proof of Nationality or Residency (birth certificate or passport) must be submitted electronically to the summer training liaison for further submission to higher authority.
